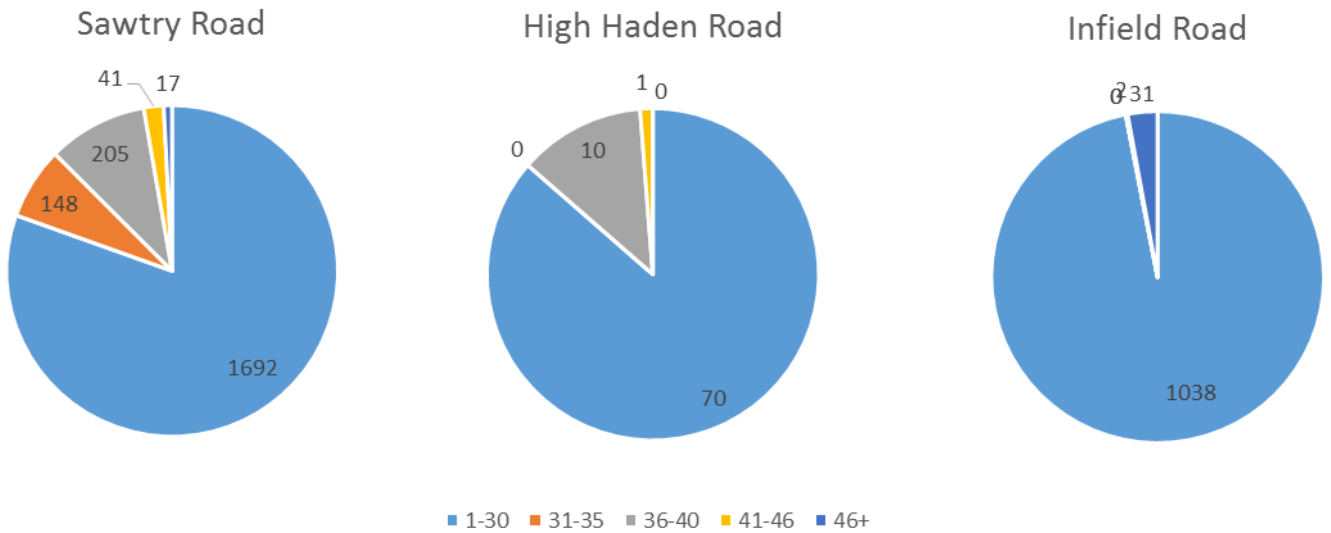
Equipment Share

Trends

- The average number of vehicles speeding in excess of the ACPO guidelines for the year up to the start of the summer school holidays was on average just over 13.5%
- Since September and the schools returning this has dropped to less than 6%
- The sessions in November recorded on average 2.1 %. (379 vehicles, 8 in excess of ACPO limits).
- The message “Don’t speed in Glatton” appears to be getting through to people.
